FIM Women's Trial World Championship
2nd round.



Laia Sanz continues making history, raising her record of trial world championship titles to eleven.

Tanvald (Czech Republic), 28.08.2011. The day after celebrating her tenth European trial title, Laia Sanz (Montesa Cota 4RT) continued making history by increasing her record of world championship titles in this motorcycle speciality to eleven. The Montesa rider won the second scoring event this Sunday, a result that has decided the championship ending on September 16th in Tolmezzo, Italy in advance. Today was Laia Sanz's 24th participation in a Women's Trial World Championship event. The plurichampion's talent and hard work has taken her to victory on 23 occasions, having finished the rest in second position.

As Laia Sanz expected, yesterday afternoon's rainfall made the terrain even more difficult and the high scores confirmed this. The plurichampion finished the first lap with 10 points, exactly half those of her closest rival, and she made the best score of the day on the second lap.

Laia Sanz: *"I think it's obvious that I'm very happy about this victory and having revalidated my world title. But with regard to this event, with slippery and difficult zones, I think I made some mistakes that I shouldn't have, perhaps due to the tension that is inevitable when a title is at stake. The tenth world title was a magical figure, but to win this eleventh championship is very special. I'm sure I have energy for some time, I'm young and feel fit, so I'm aiming for more. Nevertheless, a new generation of young girls is coming on scene, with room for progress and which must of course be taken into account"*



Laia Sanz (Corbera de Llobregat, Barcelona) born on December 11th 1985. She grew up in a highly favourable family, starting to ride a motorcycle at the age of four. She competed for the first time at the age of seven, and at eleven she began to experience winning. From then on, her progress has been unstoppable, as proven with her eleven trial world titles and ten continental titles. Laia Sanz has been riding Montesa bikes since 2004.
